Teresa McHenry, Chief of the Human Rights and Special Prosecutions Section (HRSP), asked me to review and respond to your letter to her of August 3. As you may know, HRSP prosecutes a number of federal criminal violations, including that of torture when committed outside the United States. HRSP is not, however, an investigative agency and is unable to take action on your letter. If you believe that you have been a victim of a crime, you should report the facts of your victimization to local law enforcement authorities or to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
